CONGRATULATIONS to all the students who were nominated by their school principals and Italian language teachers for the Dante Cairns, end of year School Prize for 2020.

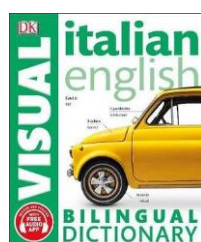
